### WINE CONCEPT

A wine for every occasion. Featuring a gastronomic wine showcasing delicate red berries.

### AGRICULTURE

The hallmarks of the 2021 vintage are subtle flavours and elegant wines. Our Merlot grapes were picked on the 1st February and our new block of Touriga Nacional picked on the 12th of February for Rose. It is a stunning blend of grapes to make our 2021 Rose – another innovation.

### VINIFICATION / MATURATION

Hand-picked grapes, destemmed, crushed, cold soaked for 48 hours, drained off skins and fermented at (16-18°C) in stainless steel tanks. Pressed to tank to retain freshness and bottled in April 2021.

### THE WINE

Gorgeous raspberry red in colour with lifted delicate red berry fragrance. The palate is fresh and fruity, with a lovely balance between freshness and elegance with red berry notes. Alc 11.7%, total acidity 5.7 g/l, pH 3.37
